

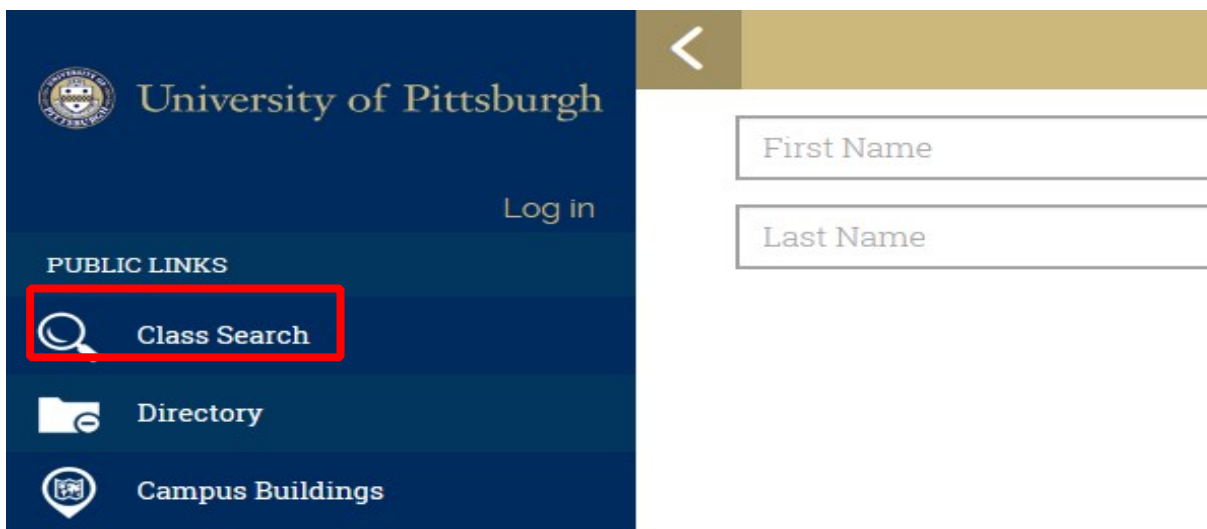
# PS Mobile Class Search

## Class Search

The Class Search is used to search for classes offered in a given term. Users do not need to log in to use the Class Search.

Click on the Class Search widget (first screen shot) or navigate to it from another area via the menu bar (second screen shot).



Select the Term, Campus, Academic Career, and Subject from the drop-down. Even though Academic Career is not a required field, the user should select the Academic Career to avoid duplicate subjects from appearing in the Subject dropdown.

**TIP: The subjects listed in the Subject drop-down list are based on the Term, Campus, and Academic Career selected. If users state they cannot find any classes for a particular subject and they know classes in a particular subject area are being offered, have them check their search criteria to make sure they have the correct values.**
